Guidelines for Authors

- Format of abstract and final paper: electronic format as MS Word document.
- Abstract should be between 250 –300 words & in English
- Name and address of author to whom correspondence should be addressed to be provided on a separate title page
- All abstracts will be reviewed and may be selected for oral or poster presentation
- English will be the language for all oral and poster presentations
- Notification of acceptance by the Committee will be e-mailed to the author
- Failure to register by the presenting author will automatically imply that the abstract will neither be included in the final program or conference CD
- Final papers should not exceed 6 000 words and must include an abstract of no more than 200 words, typed in double spacing, 12pt Times New Roman
- The Harvard style of referencing should be used
- Language editing of abstracts and final papers is compulsory
